Sec. 3.1 Housing facilities, general. Facilities and Operating Standard. (a) Structure; construction. Housing facilities for dogs and cats must be designed and constructed so that they are structurally sound. They must be kept in good repair, and they must protect the animals from injury, contain the animals securely, and restrict other animals from entering.

Beach Lab: Room 107: There is an air vent on the right wall as you enter the room that has no cover. The duct is approximately 8-9" square. This needs to be covered to be able to clean the area, and properly direct the air flow. This is important for the comfort and health of the animals.
