Patient moribund on exam. Hypothermia, tachypnea, tachycardia, 8-10% dehydration via skin tent noted. Blood glucose at 80. Initiated fluid therapy, and supportive care. 1:00pm-patient is actually worse with fluid therapy. Repeat blood glucose at 45. D/C fluid therapy. Continue rest of supportive care. 1:30pm-patient seized for approx. 1 minute. Elected euthanasia at this point.
