Supplies of food shall be stored in facilities which adequately protect the food against deterioration, molding or contamination by vermin. It was noted that on opened bag of rabbit feed in the feed storage room. The opened bags of feed should be stored in a waterproof container with a tight fitting lid. This noncompliant item was discussed and explained to management that proper storing of food supply is a necessity to protect feed against deterioration, molding or contamination by vermins.
